PRINCIPAL FUNCTIONING AGENTS

FIRST AID

GENERAL INFORMATION

CITRIWET Is a by-product from the citrus industry. Improves wetting, penetration and activation of herbicides on grass, broadleaf and woody plant species. Is a highly effective spray adjuvant designed to increase the effectiveness of pesticides.

Aquatic - Surface Submerged	1 pint - 2 quarts 1 - 2 gallons	(0.5 - 2 liters) (4 to 8 liters)
Agriculture and Citrus	1 - 2 pints	(0.5 - 1 liter)
Turf and Ornamentals	1 - 2 teaspoons per gallon or 1 - 2 ounces per 5 gallons	(5 - 10 milliliters per 4 liters) (30 - 60 milliliters per 20 liters)

NOTE: Due to variations in applications types and weather conditions, rates of CITRIWET may be increased or decreased. CITRIWET may also reduce herbicide selectivity in conifer release. Concentrated dilutions of 15% or more may cause defoliation or burn to vegetation. Always follow herbicide label recommendations.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool well-ventilated place. Use explosion-proof electrical, ventilating, lighting equipment. Keep in original container tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container. Do not store with food, feed, or other material to be used or consumed by humans or animals. Do not contaminate water supplies. For optimal storage, store between 40° and 90° F.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Dispose of contents in container to an approved waste disposal facility in accordance with all federal, state and local regulations. Triple rinse (or equivalent) adding rinse water to application tank. Offer container for recycling or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by local regulations.
